



International Flight Services Association Foundation Delta Dailyfood Scholarship Award – University of Guelph 2008

DELTA DAILYFOOD (CANADA) INC., a division of Fleury Michon S.A, a leading producer of fresh prepared meals in Europe, is a premier developer and producer of an extensive range of customized frozen meals, meal components and snacks, from breakfast to dinners, for the retail, foodservice and airline industry. The plant opened in Rigaud (Québec) in 1990 and produces approximately 25 million meals per year with distribution and delivery throughout North America and export to Asia. The plant is CFIA and USDA approved as well as HACCP certified.

Enclosed is the application for the 2008 International Flight Services Association Foundation's Delta Dailyfood Scholarship Award. Underwritten by Delta Dailyfood, this scholarship provides the opportunity for students involved in food science programs to further their education. Individuals are selected to receive the award based on scholastic merit and commitment to pursuing a career in the food processing industry with preference given to the candidate with an interest in the transportation food industry.

Award Amount:

The Delta Dailyfood Scholarship is a \$2,250 USD cash award that covers tuition, books, living expenses and associated costs. The award will be administered through the university. Once tuition, room and board, and associated costs are paid, the student will receive the residual monies at the beginning of each semester to offset associated costs.

The scholarship is available for programs leading to degrees at the following university:

Application Availability:

Candidates wishing to be considered for the award must complete the attached application, which is available via the IFSA Web site at www.ifsanet.com and by mail through IFSA Foundation Headquarters. Applications will be available beginning in January 2008 and all applications must be completed and returned to IFSA Foundation Headquarters no later than **May 15, 2008**. Applications received after **May 15, 2008** will not be considered. The recipient of the award will be notified in **July 2008**.

Award considerations:

In choosing qualified candidates, the IFSA Foundation Board will use the following selection criteria:

Selection criteria:

Academic achievement	(20%)
Initiative	(15%)
Leadership	(15%)
Communication skills	(10%)
Teamwork	(15%)
Presence in his milieu	(10%)
Financial need	(15%)

Additionally, the following criteria will also be considered by the Board:

- Have completed a minimum of 3 semesters of course study in the food science program.
- Be currently enrolled as a full time student in the food science program.
- Be a student in "good" academic standing with an average of 75% or better.
- Be able to provide official transcripts for all post-secondary, college and university studies at an accredited institution.

- Candidate to provide a letter that describes how he or she meets the selection criteria of initiative, leadership, communication skills, teamwork, presence in his/her milieu and financial need with a paragraph devoted to each criteria. The letter should also include a description of the specific course of study the candidate would like to pursue and specific goals. Work experience related to food processing in the hospitality/onboard service industry should also be noted.
- To demonstrate the selection criteria of academic achievement, provide two letters of recommendation, preferably from college or university professors, or employers who are able to address the candidate's dedication to a career preferably in the food processing industry.
- Exhibit high leadership potential.
- Be able to pursue the chosen course of study beginning with the academic year following the recipient's acceptance of the award.
